## Topic: Crimes in social media

## Activity

Goal/Aim	The activity will help to identify the phenomenon of cyberbullying and indicate methods of counteracting online violence.	
Duration	approximately 30 minutes	
Objectives	To gain / systematize the participants' knowledge about the phenomena of online violence (the concepts of cyberbulling, sexting, stalking, intimidation, harassment, cyberstalking, identity theft).	
Needed materials	Phone / tablet / computer with Internet access, cards, markers	
Instructions	<ul> <li>Divide the participants into two groups.</li> <li>Ask the participants to work out a case of cyberbullying by each group (you can choose the topic in advance, or the group is to choose it yourself), use the table.</li> <li>Ask to present the developed cases on the forum, e.g. in the form of a scenario, or through a detailed description.</li> <li>Then start a discussion on the following topics: Then start a discussion on the following topics:         <ul> <li>Could this situation have been prevented, and how?</li> <li>What was the role and motives of individual people (victim, perpetrator, witness of the incident)?</li> <li>How can you react and where to go for help in a given case?</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
