

## Topic: Let's stay in touch!

### Activity

<b>Goal/Aim</b>	This activity will focus on the basic steps that are associated with the initial use of the communication tool on your own device
<b>Duration</b>	approximately 45 minutes
<b>Objectives</b>	To find out what is the knowledge and skills with the basic operation of the device, especially with the initial launch of the application, which is oriented to communication. To answer the questions: What device will be used for communication? How to run the application on the device? How to use the application for communication?
<b>Needed materials</b>	Smartphone / tablet / computer / laptop / eReader with internet connection
<b>Instructions</b>	<p>Divide the participants into groups (2-3 people per group). Choose one communication tool for all groups to work with. (Ideally, for example, WhatsApp)</p> <p>Install and run this tool on the following devices: Group 1 = Android smartphone, Group 2 = smartphone with iOS, Group 3 = computer / laptop, Group 4 = tablet with iOS, Group 5 = Android tablet.</p> <p>Give participants enough time to discuss each step, let them use their own equipment, or entrust the equipment to them.</p> <p>Find answers to the following questions: 1. Is WhatsApp installed on the device (smartphone with Android / iOS, computer / laptop, tablet with Android / iOS)? 2. Where can we find this application to install it? 3. Have you ever installed this application yourself?</p> <p>Share the answers so that all groups can hear the answer. Then let the participants install the application on the device. Each group then acquaints all other groups with the individual steps of installation / commissioning of the device.</p> <p>We will then find the answers to the following questions: 1. Where is the application available?</p>

2. How to install the application on my device?
3. How can I use my new application for the first time?
