

## Topic: Search for a cultural event

### Activity

<b>Goal/Aim</b>	This activity focuses on the digital age, transport tickets, tickets to cultural events and other documents can be taken with you in our smart device!
<b>Duration</b>	approximately 45 minutes
<b>Objectives</b>	<p>Find out how to easily carry important documents in digital form without paper form.</p> <p>Find out what basic skills and knowledge are necessary so that we can use everything properly and comfortably.</p> <p>Get answers to the following questions:</p> <p>What equipment will be suitable?</p> <p>How to prepare the equipment?</p> <p>How can we present the relevant documents at a crucial time?</p>
<b>Needed materials</b>	Smartphone / tablet / eReader with internet connection
<b>Instructions</b>	<p>Divide the participants into several groups, ideally 2-3 people in a group.</p> <p>Give participants enough time to discuss the following question:</p> <p>How can we go to a cultural event without a paper ticket?</p> <p>Share the answers so that all groups can hear the answer.</p> <p>Find answers to the following questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. How can we get a digital ticket?</li><li>2. How can we redeem a digital ticket?</li><li>3. How to prepare our equipment?</li></ol> <p>Give participants enough time to discuss each issue.</p> <p>Then make each group a digital and paper ticket for a cultural event (each group will have a different example). Familiarize groups with the use of electronic tickets. Let them present the results to all groups.</p> <p>Then find the answers to the following questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Are e-tickets secure?</li><li>2. Is it important to supplement the electronic ticket with, for example, an identity card?</li><li>3. Will you use digital tickets?</li></ol> <p>Summarize all the important conclusions.</p>
