

Topic: Travelling

Activity

Goal/Aim	This activity focuses on other options that are associated with travel. In this case, we will work with an application that is oriented to the taxi service.
Duration	approximately 45 minutes
Objectives	Find out how a smartphone can help us when other means of transport cannot be used. Get answers to the following questions: How can our smartphone specifically help us order a taxi service? How can the application help us with the use of a taxi service? How can the application help us pay the bill for the trip using the taxi service?
Needed materials	Smartphone with internet connection
Instructions	<p>Divide the participants into groups (2-3 people per group). Select at least one local tool (application) that is associated with the taxi service.</p> <p>Install and run this tool on the following devices: = Android smartphone, = iOS smartphone Each group can use a different tool / application.</p> <p>Give participants enough time to discuss each step, let them use their own equipment, or entrust the equipment to them.</p> <p>Find answers to the following questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Where can I find tools / applications for your device?2. Do you already use an application?3. Which application did you choose?4. What do you see as the help of the application? <p>Share the answers so that all groups can hear the answer. Then have participants demonstrate tools / applications to all groups.</p> <p>We will then find the answers to the following questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. How can we use the application to pay the bill issued by the taxi driver?2. Will you try to use a tool / application on your device?3. Will you feel safer in the taxi when you use the application / tool?

Summarize all the important conclusions.
